

Harlandale Independent School District Board of Trustees
Special Call Board Meeting
June 26, 2017

The Board of Trustees of the Harlandale Independent School District met for a special call board meeting on Monday, June 26, 2017 at Central Office PDC Room, 102 Genevieve, San Antonio, Texas 78214. Mr. Carlos Quezada, President, called the meeting to order at 5:32 PM.

Roll Call: Vice President: Ricardo Moreno, Secretary: Christine Carrillo. Messrs. Juan Mancha, Esequiel Mendoza, Members. The Chair declared a quorum present. Mr. Abundis entered the meeting during Citizens to be Heard.

Staff Present: Mr. Rey Madrigal, Superintendent; Diana Tudyk, Executive Dir., Human Resources; Blanche Diaz, Recorder. Mr. Mark Sanchez, attorney.

3. The Board will conduct a final hearing on the previously proposed Non-Renewal of Chapter 21 Term contract held by Teresa Arriaga. Mark Sanchez, attorney, asked Teresa Arriaga if she was requesting an open or executive session hearing for the record. She stated “in Closed Session”. For the record, district’s legal representative identified himself as Albert Tovar, licensed attorney. Ms. Arriaga’s representative, identified herself as Gina Castaneda, advocate, not licensed.

Closed Session: Mr. Abundis *motioned to convene in Closed Session* to discuss the following agenda item and Mr. Mancha seconded:

- A. Consultation with attorney regarding hearing on the previously proposed Non-Renewal of Chapter 21 Term Contract held by Teresa Arriaga (TGC 551.071)

Messrs. Abundis, Mancha, Mendoza, Moreno, Ms. Carrillo voted in favor and the board convened in Closed Session at 5:45 PM.

Open Session: At 12:22 AM Tuesday, June 28, 2017, the board reconvened in Open Session. Mr. Abundis *motioned that the grievant be offered a one-year probationary contract that includes a comprehensive growth plan developed by the superintendent that calls for him to review her performance on a monthly basis. Upon satisfactory completion of the probationary contract, the grievant will be eligible for a contract extension subject to the superintendent’s discretion* and Mr. Mancha seconded. Messrs. Abundis, Mancha, Mendoza, Moreno, Ms. Carrillo voted in favor and the motion carried.

There being no further business, Mr. Mancha *motioned to adjourn* and Ms. Carrillo seconded. Messrs. Abundis, Mancha, Mendoza, Moreno, Ms. Carrillo voted in favor and the meeting adjourned at 12:24 AM.
