## The Board of Trustees Harlandale Independent School District

A Training of the Board of Trustees of Harlandale Independent School District will be held Monday, February 3, 2020, beginning at 5:30 PM, Central Office PDC, 102 Genevieve, San Antonio, TX 78214. The Board may go into Closed Session on any agenda item, if permitted under Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code. In such event, the Board President will announce the applicable Government Code Section prior to the Board going into Closed Session.

1. Meeting called to order
  - A. Roll call and recording of Board Members present
  - B. Declaration of quorum present.
  - C. Recording of Superintendent present.
2. Public Comment – Three-minute maximum per speaker. Citizens are offered an opportunity to address the Board without prior approval. The Board shall permit public comment on agenda items only during special called board meetings. The Board will not comment or engage in discussion. Presentations shall be informative only - no Board action will be taken. Presentations shall not include statements which may be considered defamatory, inflammatory, and/or threatening, against a person or the District; and speakers shall not mention student names unless naming your own child, nor address a complaint against a District employee or officer. Such complaints will be handled through the guidelines set out in District Policy. At all other times, members of the public shall not enter into any discussion or debate on matters being considered by the Board. The Board shall not tolerate disruption of the meeting by members of the audience. If, after at least one warning from the presiding officer, any individual continues to disrupt the meeting by his or her words or actions, the presiding officer may request assistance from law enforcement officials to have the individual removed from the meeting.
3. The Board and Superintendent will convene in a Governance Team Building session conducted by TASB.
4. Adjourn
