Appearance Policies

Appearance Entry Form

All appearance entry forms must be submitted to the Harlandale ISD Communications Department by Friday, March 20, 2020 at 4:30 p.m. Appearance forms will be reviewed and if there are any questions/concerns about your entry, someone from the Communications Department will contact you prior to the date of the event. Each mascot or a representative may pick up an information package from the Communications Office on Monday, March 30 at 5 p.m. in the Sosa Parent Center.

Entries

Each mascot can choose to participate in the parade from Mission San Jose to the Harlandale Memorial Stadium (approximately 1 mile) and/or the fair on the grounds of Harlandale Memorial Stadium. If participating in the parade, mascot can walk in or with a group, solo or as part of a float. If walking, mascot must park at the stadium and take a school bus provided by the district to the parade staging area. If riding in a float, vehicle will be assigned a number to lineup at the staging area. If only taking part in the fair, mascot is free to roam where people are gathering.

Behavior

All mascots are expected to behave in an exemplary manner. Any rudeness, foul language, inappropriate gestures or threatening behavior will be grounds for the removal of any individual from the stadium grounds and could jeopardize future participation.

Distribution of Items

Mascots may distribute articles, flyers, leaflets, brochures, souvenirs, t-shirts, etc. However, no political endorsements of any kind are allowed on district property. Distribution materials must not be offensive, graphic or contain any inappropriate language.

Parking

Each mascot will be given one parking pass. Enter through Roosevelt Ave and 92nd Street. From there, you will be directed to the parking area along Apollo and 93rd streets, by the baseball field. HISD assumes no responsibility for accidents.
