Upon creating a partnership with an IHE, the campus would be restructured to include grades 4-8.

- College and Career Readiness would be explored through multiple opportunities for career pathways and offer an accelerated curriculum.
- Teachers would receive high quality professional learning and implement research based instructional strategies (PBIS).
- Students would be encouraged to explore and create through project based learning.
- Campus culture and community will be fostered through partnerships with local community based organizations (CBO), institutions, and establishments.
- Restorative justice philosophy will guide behavior and relationships on the campus.
- Students will also be afforded the opportunity to experience fine arts disciplines, and extracurricular activities; both UIL and non UIL

TIMELINE

- Release Call for Quality Schools, Letter of Intent, and Application Template **April 21, 2023**
- District reviews applications, conducts capacity interviews, selects recommended applicants, and prepares the recommendation for the Board **Begins August 23, 2023**
- Board approves the partnership and the Performance Agreement **November 13, 2023**
- District and newly selected Operating Partner work together to prepare for the opening of the school **December 2023- July 2024**
